Genesis 18:1-8 The Three Visitors at Mamre

Insight 1: God sometimes shows up when you're <u>not expecting him.</u>

Small Group Question: Have you ever experienced God like this? If so, when, and what happened?

Genesis 18:9-10 God Reveals that Abraham and Sarah Will Bear a Son

Insight 2: God cares about things that we might not care about.

Small Group Question: What are some issues that you don't really care about? Does God care about those things? Can you see how God might want you to care about some of those things?

Insight 3: Nothing is too hard for the Lord.

Small Group Question: Are you going through something difficult right now, even something that seems impossible? How might you be able to submit to God and have hope in light of these difficult circumstances?

Genesis 18:11-15 Sarah Laughs (and Denies It)

Genesis 18:16-21 The Lord Reveals His Plans to Destroy Sodom

Genesis 18:22-33 Abraham Intercedes for Sodom

Insight 4: God plans things differently than you do.

Small Group Question: What things are you asking for right now? Would you be willing to submit and have hope — even if it doesn't go as you planned?

Submit to God

Hope in God

Small Group Question: How can you let go of your anxiety or fear about your situation and submit your cares and planning to God, trusting that he will give you hope? What makes that difficult? What or who would make that easier for you?
