Study & Discussion for Your Next Small Group

Theme: Faith-filled Friends

Share Together: Who was your best friend(s) when you were a kid/teen/college age? What was it that drew you together?

Reflect together: What impacted you the most from Sunday's message?

Read Together: Luke 5:17-26 & Matthew 18:15-19

Discuss Together:

- What might you be thinking or feeling if you were in the house and seeing this man being lowered from the ceiling?
- Why were the friends of this paralyzed man so persistent? How did Jesus show affirmation towards them?
- When Jesus said to the Pharisees, "Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'?", what point was he trying to make?
- Before Jesus sorted out the paralyzed man's physical issues, he sorted out his spiritual issues. Why did Jesus do it in this order?
- What was the response of the man who was healed and the crowd that was gathered? What impact do you think that had on the village?
- When has there been time in which you were hoping to attain or accomplish something but there were obstacles in your way (e.g., a job offer, finances, invitation to an event, or other opportunities)? What barriers were in your way that prevented or delayed the process? How did you work through them?
- Who have been your faith-filled friends that carried you through a difficult time in your life?
- Read Galatians 6:2. What is our role in carrying others to Jesus? How do we do this persistently and creatively as a faith-filled community of people? What could be the result?
- What is a burden you are carrying that others can help and pray for?

Pray Together: Take time to share how God has answered prayer and any prayer requests you have today.
