


Small Group Conversation Guide

Warm-up: What is one risk you took that paid off?

Message: Moving Forward in Faith // Read Matthew 25:14-30. Two Big Questions (taken from PROAPT):

What is it saying about God?

What is it saying about me? Who? How? Why?

- 5. What fears can keep us back from giving all of our lives to Jesus?
- 6. What things do you believe God has given you to invest in the Kingdom? For example gifts, abilities, resources, etc.
- 7. Does this story challenge or comfort you? Why?
