- 5. How do verses 18-21 add urgency to Jesus' mission?
- 6. Read James 2:14-16. How does faith connect with what we do?
- 7. In verse 20, what is the reason Jesus gives for people not coming into the light? What might we fear that Jesus will expose?
- 8. What does this passage change for you personally right now? Is it comforting, challenging, or something else?
