Theme: Surrounded

Share Together: What is your favorite card or board game and why?

Reflect Together: What impacted you the most from Sunday's message, and how is the Spiritual Practice effecting your life or attitude this week?

Read Together: 2 Chronicles 20: 1-22

Discuss Together:

- What did the people of Judah do when they heard they were surrounded by their enemies? What was Jehoshaphat's response? How would you have responded if you were him?
- What was powerful about Jehoshaphat's prayer?
- Verse 12 the king prayed, "We don't know what to do, but our eyes are on you." What is an example where you have also prayed when have felt surrounded by life's circumstances?

- What did God tell Jehoshaphat to do? How is this opposite to human military strategy?
- As God told Jehoshaphat to send the singers and musicians ahead of the army how is worship a spiritual weapon for us today?
- How is what Jesus did on the cross a declaration of the war that has already been won for our lives?
- How should we fight our battles in life in light of what Jesus has done for us?
